Marjolin's ulcer:

The surrounding depigmentation, scarring and contracture are caused by burn. Marjolin's ulcer is an eponym reserved for a squamous cell carcinoma, which arises in a long-standing benign ulcer or scar. This scar that is most commonly associated is the scar of an old burn. This carcinoma is not so invasive and slower growing.
